21 世紀的今天,全球各地無一能倖免於實質戰爭、經濟搶掠的硝煙瀰漫。掙扎並徘徊在 政治界線與社會邊緣的生活難民,已是日常生活習以為常但被視為禁忌而危險的景觀。膚 色、年齡、信仰、文化的差異,在資源拉鋸中晉級為難以消弭的衝突。無法置外的藝術, 又如何扮演另一雙眼,引領人們在既有框限之外,端詳並真正看見「差異」的複雜樣貌。 當我們面對另一個歷史的轉捩點,反思民主的內涵並審視藝術的功能與角色,似乎成為迎 接新時代的必要之事。透過藝術擴延、治理與社會承擔等面向的討論,我們希望能透過一 個更宏觀且更貼合藝術高教的視野重新思考民主,以期許未來藝術的積極角色。
